A 10 minute walk (or lift) to the seafront. The trip could include Hotham Park Gardens with its miniature railway, the boating lake and cafe or the fascinating Museum, the old Pier or even the Beach. Tuesday	16th July	1.30pm	£5	<p>Emsworth &amp; Flintstones Tea Room</p> <p>A scenic route to Emsworth via Compton and Funtindon and returning via Rowlands Castle. Emsworth has a beautiful quayside walk and plenty of shops.</p> <p>◆ Suitable for those with limited mobility if you choose to just visit the Tea Room.</p>
Tuesday	23rd July	1.30pm	£8	<p>Old Railway Station, Petworth</p> <p>A countryside drive down to Petworth railway station Tea Room with a stop afterwards in Petworth town centre to look round the shops. <i>(Make sure book the tea room as limited space.)</i></p> <p>◆ Suitable for those with limited mobility</p>
Tuesday	30th July	1.30pm	£8	<p>Titchfield Haven and Stokes Bay Tea Room</p> <p>A drive through the Meon Valley via West Meon and Wickham, going through Titchfield Haven and back along to Stokes Bay Tea Room on the seafront.</p> <p>◆ Suitable for those with limited mobility</p>

Tuesday	6th August	1.30pm	£8	<p>Hayling Island and Northney Farm Tea Rooms</p> <p>A drive to Hayling via Compton and Emsworth and along the seafront before arriving at Northney Farm Tea Rooms.</p> <p>◆ Suitable for those with limited mobility</p>
Tuesday	20th August	1.30pm	£8	<p>Fort Nelson via Meon Valley</p> <p>A drive there via Old Winchester Hill which has fantastic views of the Hampshire countryside. Fort Nelson is free to visitors. Simply just have Tea or explore the Museum beforehand too.</p> <p>◆ Suitable for those with limited mobility</p>

Tuesday 	10th September	1.30pm	£5	<p>Bishop's Palace Gardens &amp; Cathedral, Chichester</p> <p>Explore the cathedral (free entry) and the delightful Bishop's Palace Gardens hidden behind. Cloisters Refectory nearby. More details to come.</p> <p>◆ Suitable for those with limited mobility depending on how much walking you choose to do. The park has seating. (Have permission to drop off nearby)</p>
Tuesday	17th September	1.30pm	£8	<p>Goodwood, Tea at West Dean Cafe</p> <p>A drive via Lavant to view Goodwood Race track and House then on to West Dean Gardens for Tea. Time also to browse around their plant and gift shop. A return journey via Midhurst.</p> <p>◆ Suitable for those with limited mobility</p>
