Slip through the waters of beautiful Chichester Harbour on this virtually silent boat and get up close to many of the birds and habitats that make this place so special. Lunch and tea stops planned into the day. Price includes transport and the boat trip (£10).</p> <p>◆ Suitable for those with limited mobility. Lift available onto the boat.</p>
